



Rules & Regulations of the Touring Park

Touring Park

1. The site speed limit is 5mph, drivers must have valid driving licence and be insured.
2. The size of your unit must be stipulated at the time of the booking to ensure your allocated pitch is of a suitable size, if this is not done or the size of your unit alters we cannot accept responsibility if your pitch size is incorrect.
3. A maximum of one vehicle per pitch is allowed, any other vehicles must be paid for and parked elsewhere on site
4. Anyone found pitching incorrectly or using an electric hook up that has not been charged for will be required to pay the appropriate fee or may be asked to move pitch.
5. Atlantic Bays cannot accept responsibility for any accident or damage arising from the use of unacceptable electrical equipment. Electric hook up hook cables or water hoses are not provided.
6. Side awnings and full awning are permitted, gazebos are not permitted. Breathable ground sheets only.
7. BBQ's are only permitted in the designated area.
8. No decking, fencing, storage boxes or other structures are to be erected around the pitch.
9. The pitch must be kept tidy at all times.
10. Children must be supervised by a responsible adult and be responsible for their children's actions. Children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult after 9pm.
11. European caravans & motorhomes with the entrance door to the left hand side may be asked to pitch nose in to comply with fire regulations.
12. A copy of your caravan or motorhomes current insurance certificate will be required.

General

1. Atlantic Bays reserves the right to change or alter facilities available at the site and, or to change on site entertainment in the club house at any time without prior notice.
2. No noise is acceptable between the hours of 11pm and 7am. Please have consideration for your neighbours at all times.
3. Atlantic Bays caters for families and couple only and does not accept bookings from either single sex parties or groups of young adults.
4. Anyone found to be behaving in a manner that is detrimental to other holiday makers, or found causing criminal damage may at the discretion of the management to be asked to leave the site without refund. In the case of criminal damage the police will be involved.
5. Atlantic Bays does not accept responsibility for any personal items left on site. Items found will be kept for a maximum of 1 month before being disposed of. We are happy to forward your items to you at the cost of postage being charged to you.
6. No open fires, chimneys or fire pits are allowed anywhere on site.
7. No washing lines are to be strung between buildings or trees, no rotary lines.
8. Bins are allocated around the site, please ensure that all general rubbish is bagged and that any recyclable materials are put in the correct containers.
9. No ball games are permitted between chalets. Toy guns including BB guns or catapults are not permitted on the park.
10. Bicycles must be ridden with care and attention. Kite flying and ball games must be played with consideration for all other holiday makers on the park.
11. When placing a booking for a touring pitch you are deemed to have accepted the terms and conditions.

Cancellation

1. Any cancellations made will result in the loss of deposit. Cancellation made after confirmation may result in the whole cost of your booking. If a pitch can be resold then we will return your payment minus the deposit.
2. No refunds will be given if you decide to leave the park early for any circumstances including bad weather.
